

The English School, founded in 1961, is located in Colombia's capital city of Bogotá and is amongst the largest and most successful IB schools in Latin America. The school offers a bilingual education to a largely Colombian student body, working towards both the local examinations and the International Baccalaureate. We have been authorised since 1981 to offer the Diploma Programme. The English School is a private, bilingual, coeducational, international, non-denominational day school with a student enrolment of nearly 1390 from Pre-Jardin to Grade 11.

The student body is divided in 88% Colombian and 12% international (21 nationalities). Currently, there are 291 students enrolled in Grades 9 to 11 and the Class of 2024 has 89 students. Both the IB Programmes and the Colombian Baccalaureate Programme are offered and diplomas or certificates are awarded for each. All seniors, 100%, study the full Diploma Programme. The average class size is 20.


